Please be informed that MD Sight for Kids allotted our District a one thousand pieces of Prescription Eyeglasses for school children this Lion Year 2024-2025.

Each Region at the onset will be allocated 250 Rx glasses and the project proponent's requisition will be the basis for supply allocation for the lion year. All Regions have until December 8, 2024 to avail of their total allocation, after that date unused or unconsumed quota will be reallocated to other regions that may have used up their allocation.
